Play Specialist

Along side our Playologists, a Play Specialist will interact with guests and promote an exceptional Museum experience. This volunteer opportunity includes helping with daily programs, engaging children with our educational enrichment carts and tidying the exhibits. *Play specialists are needed Tuesday—Friday from 9-1, Saturdays from 10-5 and Sundays from 1-5.*

Special Event Volunteer

A Special Event Volunteer helps the Museum staff prepare for special events by assisting with set up and clean up, serving food and leading activities and crafts with families. *Special events typically occur on weekend days or after hours on Saturday evenings.*
